PRESCHOOL

- 2 large glue sticks

- 1 ruler (with inches and centimeters)
- 1 box Crayola or Prang crayons (24 –64 count)
- 1 pair large Fiskar pointed scissors
- 1 large zipper supply pouch (**NO** boxes!)
- 1 box Kleenex, full size
- 1 package felt tip pens (Crayola or like brand) with black
- 1 spiral notebook, wide ruled
- 4 ball point pens (red)
- 24 colored pencils-Crayola or Prang
- 1 set watercolor paints (Crayola or Prang)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (small size)

- 1 roll Scotch tape
- 1 Black Sharpie pen, fine point
- 24 #2 Ticonderoga pencils / Cap erasers

- 4 spiral notebooks (wide-ruled)
- 1 package notebook paper, wide ruled
- 1 set watercolor paints
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (small size)
- 1 package baby wipes
- 24 #2 Ticonderoga pencils / Erasers
- 1 book bag or backpack, **NO** rolling backpacks

GRADE 4

- 3 packages wide-ruled filler paper
- 1 pair large Fiskar scissors, pointed

- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters (not bendable)
- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- 1 large glue stick

- 1 3-ring binder (1_ inch) **NO zipper or velcro**

- 12 ballpoint pens (red) (not erasable)
- 1 package colored pencils (Crayola)

GRADE 5

Note: Students are responsible for keeping adequate supplies as items are used up. Required school assignment books will be distributed to students on Orientation Day.

- 1 2 inch 3-ring binder
- 5 ball point pens (blue or black) each quarter
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters
- 5 Papermate red pens each quarter
- 1 box colored pencils (set of 16) Not Pedigree
- 1 package felt-tip pens
- 2 Accent highlighter pens (different colors)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 pair of scissors - sharp
- 1 bottle Elmers glue
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil pouch or box

P.E. REQUIREMENTS

GRADES K-6

MANDATORY PRIOR TO ENTRY TO GRADE 6: A complete physical examination by an M.D. (on standard Lane County K-12 form).

All students **MUST** have some type of athletic shoe for the P.E. classes held every day. (Slip-on & zipper shoes tend to come off during activities.) You may purchase some to keep in the classroom or send them on days other shoes are worn. If you choose to leave them at school, please mark the shoes and the bag they are kept in.

GRADES 7-8

- 1 pair of tennis shoes
- 1 T-shirt, different from one worn to other classes
- 1 towel, if choosing to shower
- 1 pair athletic shorts of modest length or sweats, NO cargo pants (zippers, loops, pockets, etc.)
- 1 bag

Grades 6-7-8

Note: Students are responsible for keeping adequate supplies as items are used up. Required school assignment books will be distributed to students on Orientation Day.

- 20 Papermate red pens - **5 each quarter**
