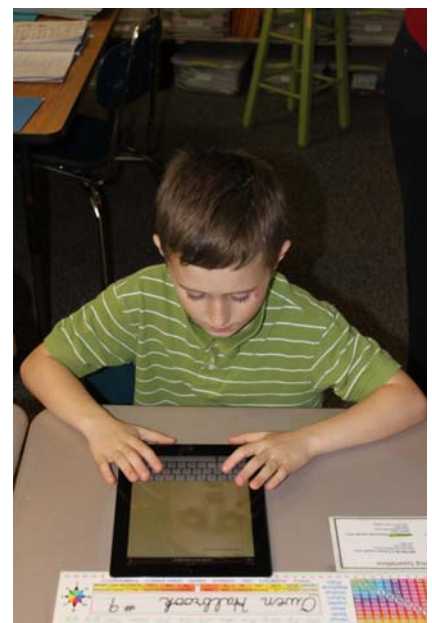
In His Peace,

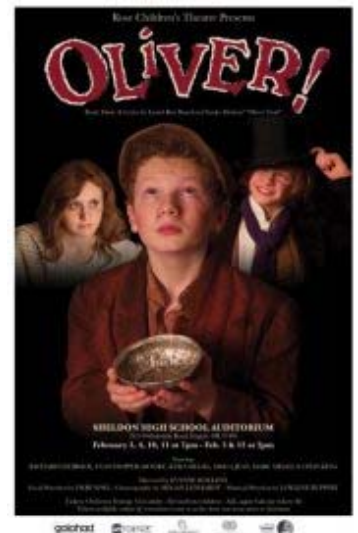
