Notes From the Principal

Dear St. Paul Families and Friends,

It has been a very peaceful and reflective week for our students and staff this week as we continue to move through Holy Week. This morning we joined together for our final prayer service of the week. We discussed with the students that today we enter into the Triduum, the three holiest days of the year.

On Holy Thursday we begin with the Mass of the Lord's Supper when we recall that Jesus gave his body and blood and taught us to care for others when he washed the disciples' feet. Tomorrow, on Good Friday, the Triduum continues with the celebration of the Lord's Passion as we remember Christ's sacrifice for us. Finally, on the night of Holy Saturday, we celebrate the great Easter Vigil, when our Savior bursts out of the tomb.

Our students have helped us reflect more deeply on Christ's passion, death and Resurrection. Today, 1st graders shared the Passion Play with parents and students from grades two through four. In the afternoon, our 8th grade students led 5th - 7th grade students in a Seder Supper, in which we reenacted the Passover.

As your family continues to prepare for the celebration of Easter, may you be blessed with an opportunity for reflection and the joy of knowing that through Christ's Resurrection he opens for us the



way to a new life.
