ST. PAUL CATHOLIC SCHOOL DRESS CODE

St. Paul Catholic School's dress code is an extension of the mission of the school. It is driven by the belief that appropriate attire facilitates the school's educational mission and displays an image of personal pride. The St. Paul Catholic School Advisory Council and Staff expect active and positive parental support. The pastor and principal are given discretion for interpreting dress code policy.

All school attire should meet the following standards at all times and be clean, neat, modest & safe.

• Look at the back of this page for the "No Thank You" list. If you still have a question, reach out and ask before you wear.

Shirts & Sweaters

- Solid-colored, striped, or plaid
- Standard polo or oxford style button down
- Turtleneck/mock neck
- Sweaters must have a collared shirt underneath
- Logos must be less than 3"x 3" in size
- Shirts may be long, short, or 3/4 sleeved
- Must be long enough to prevent the exposure of the waist

Sweatshirts

- Solid-colored, striped, or plaid
- Must be worn with a collared or turtleneck shirt underneath
- St. Paul Catholic School and Marist Catholic High School sweatshirts

Jackets & Coats

• Worn outside only

Pants & Shorts

- Solid-colored, striped, or plaid
- Jeans and dress pants
- Overalls and jumpsuits must be worn with a collared shirt/turtleneck
- Shorts must be at or above the kneecap, <u>below</u> mid-thigh and hemmed

Preschool/PreK students ONLY: to support our littlest learners – *solid-colored* leggings are considered an acceptable pant option

Dresses & Skirts

- Solid-colored, striped, or plaid
- Dresses require collars or turtlenecks and must have sleeves
- Jumpers & skirts must be worn with a collared shirt/turtleneck
- Must be below mid-thigh and hemmed
- Solid-colored tights or leggings

Hair

- Hair must be clean, well-groomed, out of the eyes, and styled in a way not to be a hindrance to learning or safety
- All hair must be a natural color

Earrings & Accessories

- Only ear piercings are allowed
- One or two stud-style earrings only
- Hoods & beanies may only be worn during recess

Make-Up

Middle school students only:

Clean, neat, modest & natural

Shoes

- Shoes must be safe & be suitable for play and P.E.
- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes only

St. Paul Spiritwear Day (Mondays)

Note: This is only offered on Mondays

• **Tops:** *St. Paul t-shirt* in lieu of a collared shirt (i.e. Jog-a-thon, Auction, OBOB, musical, athletic team, SP swag) **Bottoms:** dress code pants, shorts or skirts

Mass Dress (Wednesdays)

Note: This is every Wednesday for all students

- Students are required to dress up for Mass and prayer services
- Jeans are **not** approved
- School-approved shorts are approved
- Students are required to remove hooded sweatshirts and jackets before going to Mass and prayer services.

Pay special attention to the length of dresses, skirts, shorts, & jumpers – we bow at the altar!

Relaxed Dress Days

Note: Relaxed Dress Passes are only redeemable on Fridays. Student must present pass to teacher day of use.

All expectations are the same as the above Dress Code with the following clarifications for Relaxed Dress:

- Tops: Non-collared shirts with sleeves and sweatshirts with school-appropriate designs &/or logos
- Bottoms: Loose-fitting sweats; athletic shorts that are dress-code length or worn with leggings underneath
